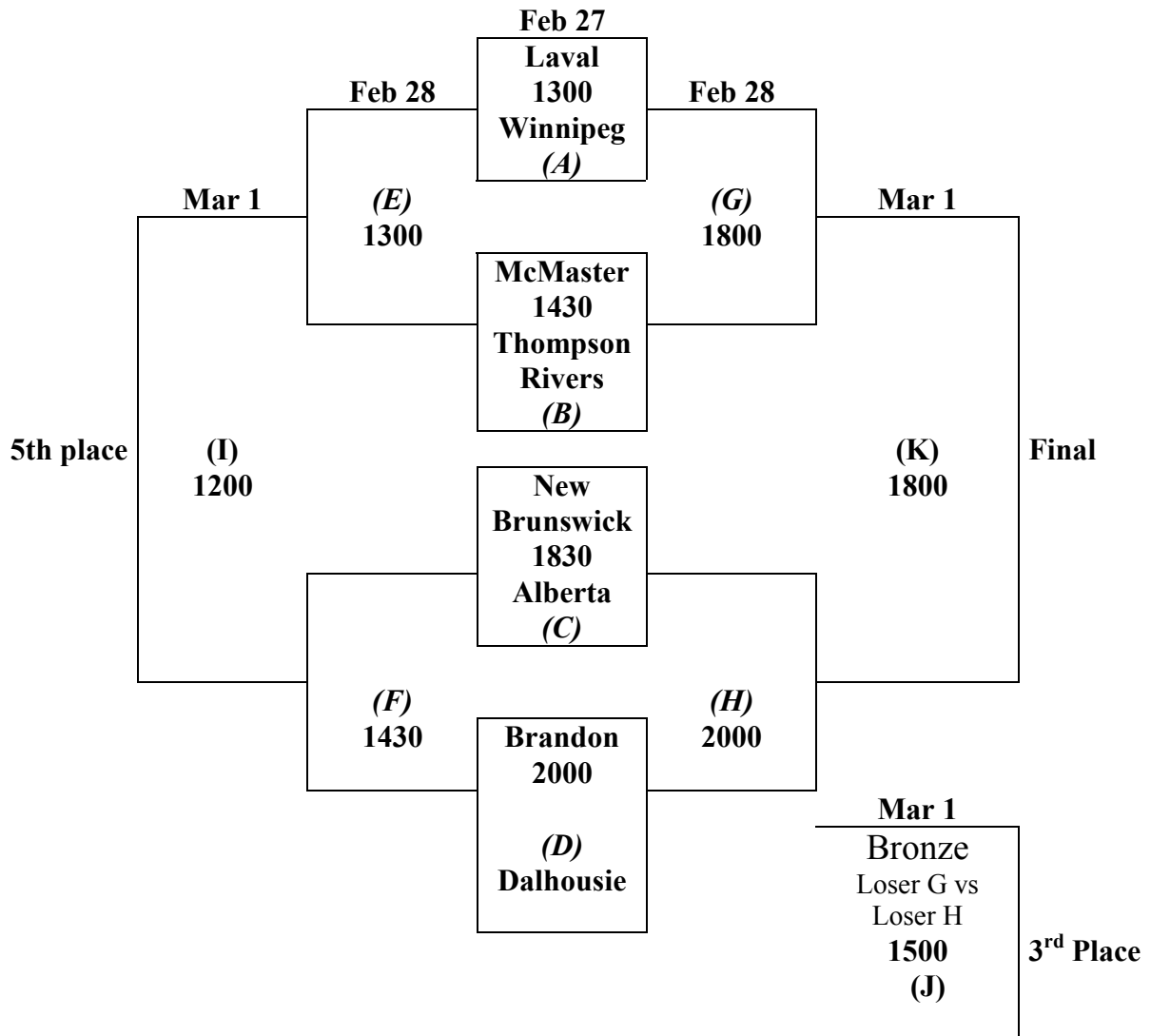

Court coverage

On-site student therapists will be available for emergency care at all practices. A certified athletic therapist will be on-site for emergency care at all games; a physician will be on-call for emergency care at all games. Emergency First aid supplies will be available at the competition venues, but teams must supply their own tape and sports supplies. If needed, supplies could be purchased from the Host Therapist for charge. There will be a charge for this service.

Clinical coverage

An appropriate referral including injury description, present treatment and treatment plan are required. There will be a training room available for treatment / therapy use with limited modalities.
