12.2 THERAPY / MEDICAL SERVICES:

The following information will describe the medical and therapy services available for your team during the CIS Wrestling Championships. The medical and therapy services operate out of the University of Calgary Sport Medicine Centre and welcome you to drop by or call (403) 220-8518 if you and questions or concerns.

Field Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student therapist will discuss the venue specific emergency action plan with the visiting medical staff prior to competition. A copy of this will be supplied to the visiting team. • If you do not have a therapist traveling with your team, we can arrange for one of the students to work with your team for a fee. If these services are required please give ample notice (1 week). Please note that the visiting team must provide any supplies utilized.
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emergency transportation will be arranged through the City of Calgary EMS located just off the campus. Non-emergency transport will be the responsibility of the visiting team. • All urgent and non-urgent injuries will be sent to Foothills Hospital Emergency located just off the main campus
Field and Emergency Supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ice, ice bags, water, and cups will be supplied to visiting teams. • A trauma kit will be on site for all competitions: The trauma kit contains: Oxygen, Blood pressure cuff, Stethoscope, Airways, Scissors, cutters, and shape-all, Splints and slings, Blood control, Stiff neck Collar, Suction, Emergency Blanket. • Crutches and Zimmer knee splints will be made available in the case of injury. There will be cost associated with the use of these supplies. A \$20 fee will be accessed for crutches and \$40 fee for a Zimmer Knee splint. • All visiting teams must travel with their provincial health care numbers and emergency contact information. • Athletes that carry health coverage from the province of Quebec need to be aware that medical services at a walk-in clinic or a hospital will be billed directly to the patient. It will be the patient's responsibility to claim with their provincial body for reimbursement. This is a common practice in Alberta. We just want you to be aware. • Any costs associated with the destruction of any medical equipment (e.g. Coolers, plinths, etc....) by the visiting team due to vandalism or misuse will be billed to the visiting team's athletic department.
Training Room	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taping facilities will be provided. Your host therapist or student will show you the location of this room. • The Jack Simpson Gym has a small first aid room that will be used to evaluate injuries that occur during a match. This room is located in the South East corner of the Gymnasium
Clinical Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to the Athletic Therapy clinic housed in the Sport Medicine Center will be granted only during regular treatment hours and in the presence of one of the University of Calgary CAT(C) Staff. This will not be available on Saturday or Sunday. • Treatment will be provided during regular clinic hours at no cost when requested by <u>written referral</u>, and when clinical load allows. • Access to the Sport Medicine Centre will be granted to the Certified Athletic Therapist or Licensed Physiotherapist where time and space is available. Proof of legal liability coverage will be necessary when utilizing the clinic.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any Extra Services such as Massage Therapy, Chiropractic, etc. will be by appointment only and the regular fee will apply to all athletes. 		
Physician Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any Athlete that needs to be reviewed by a physician will be sent to a local walk-in clinic or to the Foothills hospital, dependent on the urgency of the situation. 		
Injury Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Host medical staff will complete an injury report form for any injured athlete reviewed at the competition. 		
Medical Clearance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All participants must weigh-in and go through a skin check to be cleared to wrestle. If a wrestler has any type of skin infection, they must present a letter from a doctor, ideally a dermatologist. The letter must state that the affliction is not in the contagious phase. Medical personnel conducting the skin checks will make final determinations regarding clearance to wrestle. It is understood that an injury may occur that makes it possible for the athlete to continue to compete. However, if removal from the tournament is recommended from the attending doctor, the athlete will no longer be allowed to continue to compete in the tournament. The attending doctor has <i>final</i> say in whether an athlete continues to compete or not. The athlete and coach will be given a full explanation for the decision to remove him/her from competition by athletic staff. Note: The long-term ability of each athlete to compete in their chosen sport takes precedence over their ability to compete in the CIS/SIC Wrestling Championships
