# INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS / PROGRAMMES INTERNATIONAUX

As the national member of the Fédération Internationale du Sport Universitaire (FISU), the CIS is mandated to facilitate high-performance, international competitive opportunities for Canadian student-athletes. To be eligible, student-athletes must be between the ages of 17 and 28 in the year of the Games, and enrolled full-time in a post secondary institution.

Separate Winter and Summer Universiades (World University Games) are held every odd year, and offer competitive opportunities in over 20 sports.

In addition, 27 single-sport world university championships are offered every even year, from April to December, and are generally sports not offered at the Universiades.

Les Universiades d'hiver et d'été sont présentées à chaque année impair et permettent aux étudiants athlètes de se mesurer dans une vingtaine de disciplines.

De plus, 27 championnats mondiaux universitaires sont présentés à chaque année pair deux, habituellement dans les sports qui ne sont pas au programme des Universiades.
