COACHING STAFF



JOHN CAMPBELL, HEAD COACH

Coch Campbell is in his seventh season as head coach of the men's basketball Tigers. Prior to Dalhousie, Campbell worked as head coach of the Laurentian University Lady Vees basketball program where his team captured

two Ontario championships (CIS bronze medal and CIS fourth-place finish) and finished first in the OUA East regular season all five of his terms, with a conference record of 88-12.

His accomplishments include being selected OUA East Coach of the Year in 1999, 2001 and 2002. Coach Campbell has plenty of additional coaching experience, both as a head coach and assistant coach. He spent four seasons as head coach of the men's basketball team at Cambrian College (CCAA) as well as three summers as head coach of the North Regional team with the Ontario Basketball Association. John has also worked as an assistant men's coach in the CIS with Victoria in 1996 and with Laurentian in 1994. He was also an assistant coach with the Canadian women's under-19 team at the Francophone Games in 2001. John has a Level 4 diploma from the National Coaching Institute at the University of Victoria and is a graduate of the Physical Education program at Laurentian University where he enjoyed a successful playing career. This past summer he also assisted as a video coach with the senior men's national team. John lives in Halifax with his wife, Dianne and daughters, Renee (3) and Nicole (2).



DAVID NUTBROWN, ASSOCIATE COACH

Dave joins the staff following an extensive career in basketball at the national and international level. Dave has 25 years of head coaching experience at UPEI and Acadia. He led his teams to national Final 8 tournaments

numerous times over his career. Dave also coached with the Canadian national team program for three years including a silver medal performance in Buffalo at the FISU Games. Dave is one of the top technical coaches in the country and his ability to teach in detail is an immeasurable asset to the current players and coaching staff.



CHAD WADDEN, ASSISTANT COACH

Chad has been a head coach in Halifax, Nova Scotia at both J.L. Ilsley and Halifax West High Schools. Chad was also an assistant with the Nova Scotia provincial team and the University of Maine Fort Kent. Chad is a graduate of Dalhousie and currently
