To appoint Drew Love as chef de mission for the 2009 Summer Universiade.

Rationale:

- a) CIS called for applications for chef de mission for the Summer 2009 Universiade.
- b) Drew Love and Dick White submitted applications and were interviewed.
- c) While both candidates had impressive credentials including serving as chef for a winter, Dick White was selected.
- d) Dick White has submitted his resignation for professional reasons.

I am writing to officially advise you of my resignation as Chef de Mission for Team Canada at the 2009 Summer Universiade in Belgrade, Serbia.

During the past year I have assumed a number of roles on behalf of CIS and Canada West that were unexpected and were not part of the picture when I applied for the Chef de Mission position for this summer. I was re-appointed President of CIS, became a member of the Edmonton 2015 bid committee and served on the Canada West membership committee that reviewed three applying universities and hosted a Canada West and CIS national championship. These have all been challenging and rewarding experiences but have impacted my time, energy and excitement when it comes to a three week commitment in Belgrade. I am not confident that given these circumstances that I can provide the leadership required for these Games. I need time to re-charge my batteries and invest in my family and myself.

I am pleased to advise you that Drew Love of McGill University has agreed to step forward and assume the role of Chef. I would like to endorse Drew's nomination for this position. Drew has served as a Chef with our winter delegation in Italy, attended a FISU Congress in South Korea and was an original applicant for this role. I am confident Drew brings the experience, excitement and energy to this position required for Serbia. I will attend at least a portion of the Mission Staff meeting to provide whatever background on Belgrade I can in preparation of the staff.

I feel badly about not fulfilling this commitment but I know it is the best thing for Team Canada and myself at this time.
